## **Program Guidelines**

You must complete a total of 48\* units from the BCom List comprising -

- 16 units for all BCom Core Courses; and
- 16 units for one major from BCom Majors; and
- 16 units for either:
  - o a second major from BCom Majors; or
  - General Elective Courses

Selected courses must include at most 24 units at level 1 (excluding core courses, there will be space for up to an 8 additional units of level 1 courses).

Selected courses must include at least 8 units at level 3.

**General Electives** can come from almost any other undergraduate program at UQ providing you have met the prerequisites; they are not incompatible with any of the courses in your program, nor a prerequisite for entry to your program (e.g. you cannot gain credit for MATH1040 if you studied Mathematical Methods/Mathematics B in high school and used it to meet the maths prerequisite for the program).
