**NOTES****❖ Grades of 3**

Only #6 at a pre-2006 grade of 3 (conceded pass) can be counted towards the degree.

From Semester 2 2004, any grade of 3 obtained in a previous program cannot be granted as credit towards any new program.

**❖ MATHS B/ MATH1040 - Pre-2008 Students**

Students who entered the program prior to 2008 without having completed Maths B at secondary school or the equivalent at tertiary studies, must complete MATH1040 as a General Elective (except BBusMan(RE&D) who can enter with Maths A or equivalent). These students therefore are not eligible to complete a second major.

From 2008, all students are required to have completed Maths B or equivalent for entry to the program (including BBusMan(RE&D)).

The only exception is for domestic Qld Year 12 School leavers of 2007 (or 2006 who officially deferred commencement) who entered the program in 2008 without having completed Maths B at secondary school (except BBusMan(RE&D) who can enter with Maths A) must also complete MATH1040 as a General Elective, and are not eligible to complete a second major.

**If you have completed Maths B or an equivalent, you are not permitted to take MATH1040**, regardless of when you commenced the program.

**❖ ECON1310**

**ECON1310 is incompatible with** EC134 or EC135 or STAT1201 or 2201 or (MS101+(102 or 112) or 103 or 113 or 240.

Where students have taken the incompatible course to ECON1310 e.g. STAT1201, students may be eligible for credit or an exemption will apply.

Students who are exempt from ECON1310 are required to take a #2 BBusMan Group 3 course in replacement.

Students who completed PSYC1040+PSYC2010 prior to 2012 should contact an Academic Administrative Officer in the BEL Faculty for advice regarding ECON1310.

**\*From 2013**, ECON1020 will replace ECON1310 in the BBusMan Group 1 Compulsory Course List. If you have not successfully completed ECON1310, and wish to complete ECON1020 in its place, you may choose to transition to the new 2013 program rules and requirements. If you transition to the 2013 requirements, please complete the grad check sheet for 2013-2014 (BBusMan 2013-2014).

**❖ ECON3430**

Students who were graduating in 2008 were allowed to take ECON3550 in lieu of ECON3430 towards the Business Economics major as the latter course was cancelled.

This exception was made for graduating students in 2008 only.

**❖ FINM2401**

^ From 2014, FINM2400 Managerial Finance will replace FINM2401 Financial Management in the BBusMan group 1 compulsory course list.

If you have already successfully completed FINM2401, this course will continue to be counted towards your compulsory group 1 courses. If you have not completed FINM2401, you have the option of taking FINM2401 towards your compulsory group 1 courses or replacing it with FINM2400.

**❖ LLB courses (only applicable to previous LLB students who program change to the single BBusMan program)**

LAWS1000+LAWS1001 = LAWS1100  
(LAWS1113+LAWS2111 = LAWS1100)

An additional #2 level 1 general elective may be given as credit subject to special circumstances and approval from the Associate Dean (Academic).
