PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 48* units from the BCom list comprising -

- 16 units for all BCom Core Courses; and
- 16 units for one major from BCom Majors; and
- 16 units for either:
- (1) a second major from BCom Majors; or
- (2) General Elective Courses

*No more than 8 units can be at level 1 excluding core courses. Selected courses must include at least 8 units at level 3

Notes:

If you are intending to transfer from the BCom to BCom/LLB(Hons), you are advised to take a general elective in place of LAWS1100 in semester 2 of year one, as LAWS1100 is not transferable for credit towards the BCom/LLB(Hons) dual degree.
