PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete 64 units, comprising -

- 30 units for all BPPE(Hons) Core Courses, and
- 26 units from
 - BPPE(Hons) Major Pathway, comprising 16 units for one Major from BPPE(Hons) Majors, with at least 6 units at level 3, and
 10 units from BPPE(Hons) Program Elective Courses
 OR
 - BPPE(Hons) No Major Pathway, and
- 8 units from General Elective Courses

You must complete at least 24 units at level 3 or higher and no more than 24 units may be at level 1 (therefore, excluding core courses, no more than 12 units of major and/or elective courses can be at level 1, and at least 16 units of major/and or elective courses must be at level 3 or higher).

You must complete at least 16 units of courses at level 3 or higher at The University of Queensland (as part of the requirement for a class of Honours).
