
What you should expect

- The program is delivered fully-online, part-time.
- Courses are designed for asynchronous delivery (prerecorded content offered through learning platform). You are still encouraged to attend live sessions for coding bootcamps and case study analysis and to engage with the teaching team and your fellow peers. We focus a lot on engagement.
- Courses are delivered in 13-week semesters, and students can expect 39 class contact hours.
- Students are expected to complete additional study outside of class content including reading and completing assignments.




