PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 48 units from the BEcon course list, comprising -

- 16 units for all BEcon Core Courses; and
- 32 units for either
 - (1) Students who wish to complete two majors:
 - 16 units for one major from BEcon Majors (including at least 8 units at level 3); and
 - o 16 units for a second major from BEcon Majors (including at least 8 units at level 3);

OR

- (2) Students who wish to complete one major:
 - 16 units for one major from BEcon Majors (including at least 8 units at level 3); and
 - o 16 units of general elective courses;

OR

- (3) Students who do not wish to complete a major:
 - o 16 units of BEcon Flexible Core Courses (including at least 8 units at level 3); and
 - 16 units of general elective courses which can be chosen from BEcon Flexible Core Courses or courses from other undergraduate program course lists.

Selected courses must include at most 24 units at level 1 and at least 8 units at level 3.
