### **NOTES**

#### \* MATHS B/MATH1040 - Pre-2008 Students

Students who entered the program prior to 2008 without having completed Maths B at secondary school or the equivalent at tertiary studies, must complete MATH1040 as a Group 3 Elective. These students therefore are not eligible to complete a major. From 2008, all students are required to have completed Maths B or equivalent for entry to the program.

The only exception is for domestic Qld Year 12 School leavers of 2007 (or 2006 who officially deferred commencement) who entered the program in 2008 without having completed Maths B at secondary school must also complete MATH1040 as a Group 3 Elective, and are not eligible to complete a major.

If you have completed Maths B or an equivalent, you are not permitted to take MATH1040, regardless of when you commenced the program.

#### \* ECON1310

**ECON1310** is incompatible with EC134 or EC135 or CHEE3010 or MINE3214 or STAT1201 or 2201 or (MS101+(102 or 112) or 103 or 113 or 240.

**BE/BCom** – ECON1310 is incompatible with STAT1201 or STAT2201.

**BCom/BInfTech & BCom/BSc** – ECON1310 is incompatible with CHEE3010 or MINE3214 or STAT1201 or STAT2201.

Where students are required to take the incompatible course to ECON1310 for the External dual component e.g. STAT1201, an exemption will apply.

Students who are exempt from ECON1310 are required to take a #2 course from group 3 of the BCom course list in replacement.

Students who completed PSYC1040+PSYC2010 prior to 2012 should contact an Academic Administrative Officer in the BEL Faculty for advice regarding ECON1310.

#### \* MGTS1201

**BE/BCom & BCom/BSc** – MGTS1201 is incompatible with INFS1200. Where students are required to take INFS1200 for the BE or BSc component, an exemption will apply for MGTS1201. Students who are exempt from MGTS1201 are required to take a #2 course from group 3 of the BCom course list in replacement.

**BCom/BInfTech** - CSSE1001 must be completed in lieu of MGTS1201.

#### Grades of 3

Only #8 at a pre-2006 grade of 3 (conceded pass) can be counted towards the dual degree (#8 across both components – NOT #8 each).

From Semester 2 2004, any grade of 3 obtained in a previous program cannot be granted as credit towards any new program.

#### \* BCom

If student completes CO131 prior to 1999, and they study Business Law and CO336 in the same semester, they can count a 7<sup>th</sup> Gp C2 course in lieu COMM2302.

If student has received credit for COMM2302, LAWS1101 and a #2 block, then they are OK for LAWS1100.

LAWS1000 + LAWS1001 = LAWS1100 + #2 electives (level 1).

If completed CO121 + CO222 they do not need to do COMM2302 but if they do... COMM2302 student can use COMM2302 as an elective.

But if completed CO121 but not CO222 then student must complete LAWS1100 and BSAC2101. They will receive no credit for CO121.

CO111 or COMM1101seek approval from director of studies to use in lieu of COMM1301.

### ❖ BCom/BEd(Secondary)

(pre-2007) EDUC3079 must be included within #12 for a major or Group 3 Electives.

## BCom/BInfTech

INFS3222 must be included within #12 for a major or Group 3 Electives.

LAWS1000+LAWS1001 = LAWS1100 (LAWS1113+LAWS2111 = LAWS1100)

LAWS4112 = LAWS3100 towards Accounting major. LAWS5144 = LAWS3101 towards Accounting major.
