***ECON1050 is incompatible with** EC131 or MATH1050 or MATH1051.

****ECON1310 is incompatible with** EC134 or EC135 or CHEE3010 or MINE3214 or STAT1201 or 2201 or (MS101+(102 or 112) or 103 or 113 or 240.

Where students have taken an incompatible course to ECON1050 and/or ECON1310, they may be eligible for credit or an exemption will apply.

Students who are exempt from ECON1050 and/or ECON1310 are required to take a #2 BEcon course in replacement of each #2 exemption.

If you completed ECON1050 + MATH1050 prior to 2013, or you completed ECON1050 + MATH1051 in 2013, please contact an Academic Administrative Officer in the BEL Faculty for advice.

Students who completed PSYC1040+PSYC2010 prior to 2012 should contact an Academic Administrative Officer in the BEL Faculty for advice regarding ECON1310.
