

### Getting a great job

BAdvFin&Econ(Hons) already has a strong reputation among investment banks, fund managers, private equity firms and management and economic consulting firms.

#### Three key tips:

- Look out for opportunities for relevant part-time work.

### What does a course look like?

At UQ, we call subjects 'courses'.

A course may consist of lectures, seminars, online modules, as well as tutorials and workshops. Lectures and seminars start in week 1, tutorials generally start in week 2.

This semester courses will mostly be delivered in person (on campus), but some may be delivered externally (online).

### What is going to happen in a course?

All the details of what will happen in each course will be covered in the **Course Profile** (CP). Just search for the course code.

This guide will tell you what **learning resources** you need, what **activities** are scheduled for each week, and how you are going to be **assessed**.

Section 6. *Policies and Guidelines* has all the information and links you need for understanding academic integrity, extensions, feedback etc.

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### What do you have to do?

We manage the scheduled activities and provide everything you need to study the course on the **course Blackboard**.

It is up to you to **prepare for class**, complete any online modules or reading required to participate, schedule time to complete assessments, and work with others in your class.

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#### What is class time for?

Class time is a time where you can think about the knowledge being presented. It is time for you to **ask questions**, gain an understanding of the course content, and get some experience in using the knowledge.

Knowledge and experience don't just happen – **you have to be an active learner**.

- Come to class!
- Ask lots of questions.
- Engage with classmates.

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### How will you be assessed?

It depends on each course as to the best way to assess your learning. Be sure to check the CP for details of when and how you will be assessed.




UNIT is Australia's largest student-run society across six leading universities and is geared towards those interested in finance, investing and trading





#### Who We
