PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 48 units from the BEcon List comprising -

- 22 units of compulsory courses from Group 1; and 26 units from either
 - 1) Student who wish to complete a major:
 - o 12 units from one major in Group 2 (with at least 6 units at level 3); and
 - o 6 units from Group 3; and
 - 8 units of general electives; or

OR

- 2) Students who do not wish to complete a major:
 - o 18 units from Group 3; and
 - 8 units of general electives.

Excluding group 1, no more than 8 units (4 courses) may be level 1 courses and at least 8 units (4 courses) must be level 3 courses.

Students wishing to complete a second major may use their Group 3 and general electives to do so, ensuring that 6 units from the major are level 3 courses and that courses do not overlap with first major.
