You are not required to submit this program plan for approval. PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 48 units from the BBusMan course list comprising -

- 24 units of compulsory courses from Group 1; and 24 units (with no more than 4 units at level 1) from either:
 - (1) Students who wish to complete a major:
 - o 12 units from one major in Group 2 (at least 6 units must be from level 3 courses); and
 - 12 units of general elective courses from Group 3 or from almost any other undergraduate program in the University. No more than 4 units may be from level 1* courses; or
 - 24 units from two majors in Group 2, each comprising 12 units (at least 6 units in <u>each major</u> must be from level 3 courses; no overlap of courses permitted between two majors);

OR

- (2) Students who do not wish to complete a major:
 - 12 units of elective courses from Group 3 (at least 6 units must be from level 3 courses, and no more than 2 units may be from level 1* courses); and
 - 12 units of general elective courses from Group 3 or from almost any other undergraduate program in the University. No more than 4 units may be from level 1* courses (if you have taken a level 1 course towards your Group 3 electives, then no more than 2 units may be at level 1 for your general electives).

*Maximum 4 units (2 courses) at level 1, excluding group 1 courses.

If you are completing the Real Estate and Development major and undertake the additional 12 units of courses (required for professional membership) as a substitute for general electives, then you are permitted to complete 6 units of level 1 courses listed in the real estate and development major course list. Refer to the BBusMan rules for further information.

General Electives can come from almost any other undergraduate program at UQ providing you have met the prerequisites; they are not incompatible with any of the courses in your program, nor a prerequisite to your program (e.g. you cannot gain credit for MATH1040 if you studied Mathematics B in high school and used it to meet the maths prerequisite for the program).
