PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 64 units from the BAdvBus(Hons) course list comprising -

- 28 units of compulsory courses from Part A; and
- 12 units from one major in Part B; and
- 24 units for either –
 - (1) Students who wish to complete a professional pathway:
 - a) 12 units from a second major in Part B; and
 - b) either –
 - i. 12 units from a third major in Part B; or
 - ii. 12 units of electives comprising 4 units from Part B and 8 units from any combination of other courses in Part B and/or other undergraduate courses at the University approved by the Executive Dean (6 units must be at level 3).
 - (2) Students who wish to complete a research pathway:
 - a) 16 units from Part C; and
 - b) 8 units of electives from any combination of other courses in Part B and/or other undergraduate courses at the University approved by the Executive Dean.

Students will be required to complete the first 40 units of the program with a cumulative GPA of at least 5.5 to be eligible for the research pathway.

Where the same course appears in more than one major, it can only be counted once towards one major.
