PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 64 units from the BAdvFin&Econ(Hons) course list comprising -

- 44 units of compulsory courses from Part A; and either
- For a major:
 - o 16 units from one major from Part B; and
 - o 4 units of elective courses from Part C; or
- For the generalist/professional pathway:
 - o 16 units of elective courses from Part C; and
 - o 4 units from Part D.

For the Economics major, students must have a GPA of 5.5 for Part A of the program, and a grade of 5 in ECON2050, ECON3010, ECON3020 and ECON3350.

For the Finance major, students must have a GPA of 5.5 for Part A of the program, and a grade of 5 in FINM2411, FINM3411 and FINM3412.
