PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete 64 units, comprising -

- 36 units for Part A; and
- 8 units of general electives; and
- 20 units for either -
 - one major in Part B and 4 units from Part C; or
 - 14 units from Part C and 6 units from Part D

Note:

For the Economics major, students must have a GPA of 5.5 for Part A of the program, and a minimum grade of 5 in ECON2050, ECON3010, ECON3020 and ECON3350. Note: ECON3010 and ECON3020 (Part C electives) are required pre-requisites for enrolment in the Economics major.

For the Finance major, students must have a GPA of 5.5 for Part A of the program, and a minimum grade of 5 in FINM2411, FINM3411 and FINM3412.
