

THE J. M. DONNELLY SCHOLARSHIP - 2016 APPLICATION FORM

APPLICATION CLOSING DATE 25TH JULY 2016

The J.M.Donnelly Scholarship was established in 2015. In making a gift to the University, Janelle Donnelly wishes to honour her commitment to provide opportunities for academically qualified female students enrolled in a program at the Faculty of Business, Economics and Law and who are of Samoan heritage and have financial needs. The Value of the Scholarship is \$3,000 per year.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

One scholarship is available each year. To be eligible for the Scholarship a student must be a female, domestic student in accordance with the fee rules, of Samoan Heritage and be enrolled full time in an undergraduate program administered by the Faculty of Business, Economics and Law and can prove financial need. This is an annually awarded scholarship.

To be eligible for the Scholarship a student must:

1. be a female,
2. a domestic student in accordance with the fee rules
3. enrolled full time in an undergraduate degree program administered by Faculty of Business, Economics and Law;
4. for commencing students have achieved an entry level OP minimum of 11 or the equivalent if originating from another Australian state or territory or for continuing students have a GPA of at least 4.0;
5. be able to demonstrate financial need;
6. provide proof of their Samoan heritage;
7. provide a statement outlining the impact the Scholarship will make to their life at UQ and their community.

The Scholarship Selection Committee will give added consideration to candidates who have made a meaningful contribution to society; are well-balanced; who hold a wide-range of interests; and who are seeking professional opportunities beyond an academic career.

The value of the scholarship is \$3000 per year.
