PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete 64 units, comprising -

- 36 units for all BAdvFin&Econ(Hons) Core Courses; and
- 8 units of BAdvFin&Econ(Hons) General Elective Courses; and
- 20 units for either -
 - BAdvFin&Econ(Hons) Major Pathway (including 16 units for one major from BAdvFin&Econ(Hons) Majors and 4 units from BAdvFin&Econ(Hons) Flexible Core Courses); or
 - BAdvFin&Econ(Hons) General Pathway (including 14 units from BAdvFin&Econ(Hons) Flexible Core Courses) and 6 units for all BAdvFin&Econ(Hons) General Pathway Courses.

Note:

For the Economics major, students must have a GPA of 5.5 for BAdvFin&Econ(Hons) Core Courses, and a minimum grade of 5 in ECON2050, ECON3010, ECON3020 and ECON3350. Note: ECON3010 and ECON3020 (BAdvFin&Econ(Hons) Flexible Core Courses) are required pre-requisites for enrolment in the Economics major.

For the Finance major, students must have a GPA of 5.5 for BAdvFin&Econ(Hons) Core Courses of the program, and a minimum grade of 5 in FINM2411, FINM3411 and FINM3412.
