PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete 64 units, comprising -

- (1) For BPPE(Hons) Team Project Pathway
 - a) 38 units for all BPPE(Hons) Core Courses; and
 - b) 2 units for BPPE(Hons) Team Project Course PPES4201; and
 - c) 18 units for either
 - i. 12 units for one BPPE(Hons) major, and, 6 units from Flexible Core Courses* of which at least 2 units must be at level 3; or
 - ii. 18 units from the No Major Option Courses* of which at least 6 units must be at level three; and
 - d) 6 units of General Elective Courses*

<u>OR</u>

- (2) For BPPE(Hons) Thesis Pathway
 - a) 38 units for all BPPE(Hons) Core Courses; and
 - b) 6 units for BPPE(Hons) Thesis Course PPES4202; and
 - c) 14 units for either
 - i. 12 units for one BPPE(Hons) major, and, 2 units from Flexible Core Courses*; or
 - ii. 14 units from the No Major Option Courses* of which at least 2 units must be at level three; and

d) 6 units of General Elective Courses*

Note:

*For Flexible Core and General Elective Courses combined, or, No Major Option and General Elective Courses combined, a student must complete no more than 4 units at level 1.
