PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 48 units from the BBusMan course list comprising -

- 16 units for all BBusMan Core Courses; and\
- 16 units for one major from BBusMan Majors and
- 16 units from either:
 - o a second major from BBusMan Majors; or
 - o General Elective Courses

Selected courses must include at most 24 units at level 1 (excluding core courses, there will be space for up to an additional 8 units of level 1 courses).

Selected courses must include at least 8 units at level 3.

General Electives can come from almost any other undergraduate program at UQ providing you have met the prerequisites; they are not incompatible with any of the courses in your program, nor a prerequisite for entry to your program (e.g. you cannot gain credit for MATH1040 if you studied Mathematical Methods or Mathematics B in high school and used it to meet the maths prerequisite for entry into the program).
